For **master's degree** programs you will need:

- a bachelor's degree
- adequate certification of your German language skills (e. g. DSH 2, TestDaF 4), if applicable.

Special admission requirements apply for the International Business bachelor's degree program as well as for the master's degree programs in International Marketing and in International Finance and Economics.

How to apply

Incoming freshmen can only enroll for the winter semester, which starts in October. The only exception is the bachelor's degree program in Design, for which applications are additionally accepted in the summer.

The following application periods apply:

- Winter semester:

May 2 to June 15 (exclusion period for programs having restricted admission)

Exception: May 15 to May 31 for the bachelor's degree program in Design

- Summer semester:

December 1 to January 15

Exception: December 1 to December 15 for the bachelor's degree program in Design

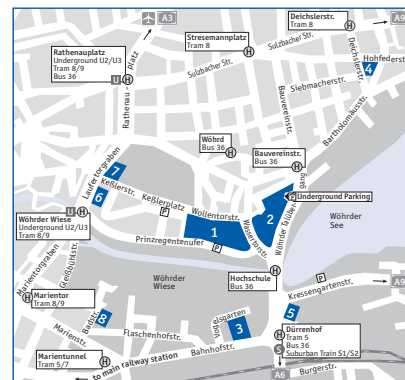
