

Important Information for all First-Year Students in the WS 2010/11

Dear Freshmen,

All students at our university receive an electronic Student ID, known as the OHMcard, when they enroll.

Unfortunately the chip cards manufacturer could not deliver them in time this semester and there were not enough remaining cards for all the new students. For this reason you will not (yet!) receive an OHMcard when you register.

Instead you can print out a substitute Student ID.

This is how you print out your substitute ID:

When you enroll you receive a student data sheet with your personal my.ohm user data (user name and password). On the day **after** registration, at the earliest as of 12 noon, this will allow you access to the central IT infrastructure of the university.

Log in under

with your user name and your initial password.

Then change this initial password to one of your own choice. The instructions on how to do this can be found on the website of the data center under:

Log in here with your my.ohm user data, i.e. with your user name and your new personal password.

1. Click on [Studienbescheinigungen](#)

3. Select [Ersatz-Studierendenausweis](#).
4. Click on the blue bar with the words [Bescheinigung als PDF anzeigen](#).
5. A PDF file will open, which you now print out.

This substitute student ID is your admission ticket to the central welcoming ceremony on October 1, 2010 at the NürnbergMesse exhibition center. Be sure to take it along!

The substitute student ID is valid solely in combination with your personal ID.

To make use of the university library use the student data sheet with the barcode, which you received when you registered (also in conjunction with the personal ID).

As soon as the card manufacturer can deliver the chip cards, you will be informed by e-mail as to when and where you can pick up your personal OHMcard.
